2009-2010

Good afternoon Ladies and Gentlemen, and welcome to our 37th Annual General Meeting at Chennai.

It gives me pleasure to share the happenings and highlight some of the achievements of the FMSCI in the year 2010.

It has been a very hectic and exciting year; the JPSI F1 Track at Noida is progressing on schedule and we hope the track inspections in June 2011 will pave the way for the first ever Indian Formula 1 Grand Prix. With an investment of over \$450M in this facility it certainly has put India on the Global motorsport map . The Madras Motor Sports Trust has also spent over Rs.75 Lakhs to just get a professional Vision plan to upgrade the racing facility in the years ahead .

We are seeing a hectic amount of activity and workload at the Secretariat related to this including the training of the marshals that has started for this prestigious event & to build up a pool of officials who can then serve at many FMSCI events .

We must thank our Chairman Dr.Vijay Mallya at the forefront of the activity in ensuring that the World Motor Sports Council announced the FIA Annual Awards & the 2011 FIA AGM & WMSC meetings on their calendar. With the inspection of the track by FIM, we also hope that the MotoGP will come to India in 2012.

Our efforts in promoting motorsports pan India have borne fruit and we have seen almost a 50% increase in issue of permits for 2010. The competition licenses have also shown a very healthy trend of over 25% increase over last year.

I urge all our member clubs and especially those on the Council to look at organizing more and more events to help us achieve another 50% growth for next year.

To promote the activities of our Federation and to give a wider corporate coverage to our events we have appointed Adrenna Communications , a media and PR agency. We hope this will ensure a wider footprint across the nation in electronic and print media for our events giving a fillip to sponsors of events and competitors and FMSCI itself.

Finances

Our financial position is showing a healthy trend and we can look forward to 2011 with optimism and expect sponsors from the industry to contribute to growth of motorsport in the country.

The 2010 FMSCI Indian National Rally Championship for 4 wheelers is sponsored by SPEED of Bharat Petroleum and the commercials handled by the promoters IMG Sports & Pro Sports Promotion, Bangalore.
